Adults who have never been baptized and adults who would like to complete their Christian Initiation are invited to participate in this programme. Preparation sessions for the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) will begin in a couple of weeks. Those who are prepared will be baptized or will complete their Christian Initiation at the Easter Vigil, Saturday, April 4, 2015.

Those who have been baptized in another Christian tradition and who wish to enter into the full communion of the Catholic Church will be received individually, according to the preparation that may be needed. Children in grade 3 or higher who now wish to become Catholics, but who have never been baptized or who have been baptized elsewhere, can also begin a period of instruction and preparation.
