RECIPE OF THE WEEK: NO BAKE COOKIES

A super fast, super easy to make cookie made with chewy oatmeal, rich cocoa and creamy peanut butter.

Ingredients

- 1/2 c. salted butter
- 1 3/4 c. granulated sugar
- 1/3 c. unsweetened cocoa powder
- 1/2 c. milk
- 1 tsp vanilla extract
- 2/3 c. creamy peanut butter
- 3 c. quick oats

Instructions

1. Line 2 baking sheets with parchment paper.
2. Combine butter, sugar, cocoa and milk in medium saucepan.
3. Cook on medium, stirring frequently until boiling for 60 seconds.
4. Remove from heat, add vanilla, peanut butter and oats.
5. Stir mixture well, drop onto parchment paper using 2 tbsp. size scoops.
6. Let sit at room temperature for 20 min. and enjoy! Store in airtight container at room temperature.
