RECIPE OF THE WEEK: COCONUT, CHOCOLATE & PECAN COOKIES

Ingredients

- 400 g sweetened shredded coconut
- 2 cups semisweet chocolate chips
- 1/3 cup chopped pecans
- 300 ml can condensed milk

Directions

1. In large mixing bowl, mix together coconut, chocolate chips, pecans and condensed milk.
2. Form into 2 inch balls.
3. Transfer to baking sheet; flatten slightly
4. Bake until lightly browned on top, 15 - 18 minutes. Let cool.
