"REPENT SAYS THE LORD; THE KINGDOM OF HEAVEN IS AT HAND"

Lent's call to repentance is a call to turn around. The Greek word for repent is "metanoia." It means "to think differently after," and indicates a change of mind, heart or consciousness. Repentance requires the willingness and humility to recognize we have lost our way and our need to change. All of us have something for which we need to repent: a person we have wronged, a good we have neglected to do, a cruel or unkind word we have spoken. We have all been less than lovely, less than faithful and less than gracious from time to time with others and with ourselves.
