THE OUTPOURING OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

"The Counselor, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, he will teach you all things, and bring to your remembrance all that I have said to you" (John 14:25). Ceaselessly the Holy Spirit brings to our remembrance the life-giving words of Jesus: "This is my body which is given for you" (Luke 22:19).

In the Eucharistic Prayer, while giving thanks to the Father, the Church "implores the power of the Holy Spirit that the gifts offered by human hands be consecrated, that is, become Christ's Body and Blood" (*GIRM*, 79). The Church also prays that, by the action of the Holy Spirit, "the spotless Victim to be received in Communion be for the salvation of those who will partake of it" (*GIRM*, 79).

At the Annunciation (cf. Luke 1:35) the Holy Spirit overshadowed the Virgin Mary, forming the Body of Christ in her womb. At Pentecost (cf. Acts 2:4) the Holy Spirit was present in a mighty wind and tongues of fire to form the Body of Christ, the Church. In every Mass the Holy Spirit makes fruitful the Church's obedience to the command of Christ: "Do this in memory of me" (Luke 22:19). (Source: the Archdiocese of Philadelphia)
