THE SOLEMNITY OF CORPUS CHRISTI

This **Sunday, June 11**, the Church celebrates the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, often referred to as Corpus Christi. A tradition often associated with Corpus Christi is a procession of the Blessed Sacrament in the community, ending with Benediction. Please join us after the 11 am Mass for a short procession. A procession is a very concrete, visual way to witness to and celebrate our Catholic faith. All are welcome.
