## **DECEMBER 10, 2023**

#### **BAMBINELLI SUNDAY**

For the past several decades, each year on Gaudete Sunday, The Third Sunday of Advent, children (and adults) bring their Baby Jesus figures from the crib at their homes to St. Peter's Square where the Pope will bless both the people and the figurines during the Angelus.

This year we will celebrate "Bambinelli Sunday" at St. Patrick's Parish following the 5 pm Mass on December 16 and the 9 and 11 am Masses on December 17. All are invited to bring the Baby Jesus figure from their home to Mass to be blessed.

A suggestion is, following the blessing, take your "bambinelli" home and place it in a gift box, wrap it, and save it for Christmas. Let this be the **FIRST GIFT** your family opens on Christmas morning, when together you place your Baby Jesus figure in the crib.

## THE FIVE PRECEPTS OF THE CATHOLIC CHURCH

The five precepts of the Catholic Church are a description of the absolute minimum spiritual requirements of Catholics regarding the Church. They are as follows:

- You shall attend Mass on Sundays and on holy days of obligation and remain free from work or activity that could impede the sanctification of such days.
- 2. You shall confess your sins at least once a year.
- 3. You shall receive the sacrament of the Eucharist at least during the Easter season.
- 4. You shall observe the days of fasting and abstinence established by the Church.
- 5. You shall help to provide for the needs of the Church.

#### HOLY DAYS OF OBLIGATION

In Canada, the holy days of obligation are the following: every Sunday, Christmas Day (December 25) and the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God (January 1).

On holy days of obligation, the faithful gather to express the fact that the Church is not self-generated but is always called to worship by God. On that occasion, we come to hear the Word of God, take part in the Eucharist and give thanks to the Lord for having been incorporated into Christ. Therefore, one must take part in the celebration of Mass either on the same day or at the vigil Mass on the previous evening.
