HOLY DAYS OF OBLIGATION

In Canada, the holy days of obligation are the following: every Sunday, Christmas Day (December 25) and the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God (January I).

On holy days of obligation, the faithful gather to express the fact that the Church is not self-generated but is always called to worship by God. On that occasion, we come to hear the Word of God, take part in the Eucharist and give

thanks to the Lord for having been incorporated into Christ. Therefore, one must take part in the celebration of Mass either on the same day or at the vigil Mass on the previous evening.
