On June 29, the Church celebrates the Solemnity of Sts. Peter and Paul to honor the two great apostles Peter and Paul. St. Peter, one of the Twelve and the chief of the Apostles, the

Rock upon which Christ built His Church, and St. Paul "called to be an apostle, set apart for the gospel of God" (Romans I:I) and Apostle to the Gentiles. Together they are honored as founders of the Church of Rome, having been separately martyred there during the reign of Emperor Nero. "Christian tradition has always considered Sts. Peter and Saint Paul to be inseparable: indeed, together, they represent the whole Gospel of Christ." (Pope Benedict XVI)


SVDP PANTRY IN NEED OF FOOD FOR THE SUMMER MONTHS
