### THE FEAST OF CHRIST THE KING

The Feast of Christ the King was established by Pope Pius XI in 1925 as an antidote to secularism, a way of life which leaves God out of man’s thinking and living. The feast is intended to proclaim in a striking and effective manner Christ’s sovereignty over individuals, families, society, governments and nations. Originally celebrated on the last Sunday in October, it is now celebrated on the last Sunday in Ordinary Time in the liturgical year. The following are the words of Pope Pius XI in the Encyclical *Quas Primas* - On the Feast of Christ the King: **“He must reign in our minds, which should assent with perfect submission and firm belief to revealed truths and to the doctrines of Christ. He must reign in our wills, which should obey the laws and precepts of God. He must reign in our hearts, which should spurn natural desires and love God above all things and cleave to him alone. He must reign in our bodies and in our members, which should serve as instruments for the interior sanctification of our souls.”** QP # 33
