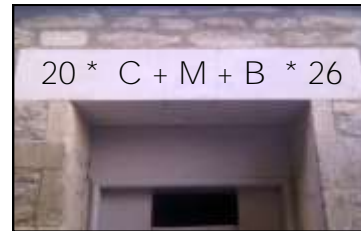

CHALKING THE DOOR AT EPIPHANY

This liturgical year we are inviting parishioners to chalk their doors at Epiphany. Blessed chalk will be made available on the weekend of January 3 & 4, 2026. The blessed chalk is to be used to inscribe a simple formula on the lintel of your door. The formula includes the numerals for the year in question and the letters C + M + B. You then say a simple prayer asking God to bless your home. The formula looks like this.



So what do the letters "C, M and B" stand for? Most people will tell you that they stand for the names of the three wise men – Caspar, Melchior and Balthasar – and that is certainly a venerable tradition – but the letters also stand for the Latin phrase *Christus mansionem benedicat* which means "May Christ Bless this House."
