THE MEANING OF
CONVERSION AND REPENTANCE

“Conversion” and “repentance” mean essentially the same thing. “Conversion” does not mean merely changing religious affiliations. It means literally a “turn-around” - turning one’s heart and will and life over to God. And “repentance” does not mean merely feeling sorry or remorseful. “Interior repentance is a radical reorientation of our whole life, a return, a conversion to God..., a turning away from evil,...the desire and resolution to change one’s life, with hope in God’s mercy and trust in...his grace” (CCC 1431).
