MARCH FOR LIFE - OTTAWA
MAY 14

Why do we march? There were approximately 101,533 abortions in Canada in 2023 - 4,342 more abortions than in 2022. Since abortions became legalized, Canada has aborted 4.5 million preborn babies.

Statics from 2020 indicate that 96 % of abortions are performed due to social or economic reasons and 4% of abortions are performed because of rape, incest, physical health, a fetal disability or the health of the mother. Therefore, we march in order to call upon Parliament to enact legal protection for all human beings from conception to natural death.

Why march on a Thursday and in Ottawa? On Thursday, in most years, our legislators are sitting in the House of Commons and we want them to hear us. Please consider joining one of the buses leaving Guelph or Hamilton at 5:45 am to make your voice heard. Call 519-623-1850 to reserve your seat.
