(MAGNIFICENT HUMANITY)**

His Holiness Pope Leo XIV has released his first encyclical, Magnifica Humanitas, entitled On Safeguarding the Human Person in the Time of Artificial Intelligence.

In this encyclical, the Holy Father reflects on the opportunities and challenges presented by artificial intelligence and emerging technologies, while reaffirming the dignity of the human person, the value of work, the importance of truth, solidarity, peace, and the common good.
